AM I ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible if you meet the following requirements...

- You are active in the life of the Episcopal Church
- You (or your parents/guardian) are a member of a congregation in our Diocese
- You are advancing your post-secondary education through a certified accredited institution (including Associate & Bachelor) on a full-time basis.

Seminarians / Postulants are not eligible for these scholarships.

All applications received will be reviewed to ensure all eligibility requirements are met.

All scholarships will be reviewed/approved by the Bishop.

HOW DO I APPLY?

There are a few steps to follow in the application process:

- 1. Review/complete the five (5) sections on the application form in full
- 2. Provide transcript(s) from your most recent academic work
- 3. Obtain your letter of reference (one)
- 4. Complete your essay (select only one question to answer)
